BRIEF REPORT:

*The DAV P.G. College was established in 1938 as an Intermediate College recognized by Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. The idea of establishing the college as an extension of Banaras Hindu University in the heart of the city originally conceived by Pandit Ram Narayan Mishra and Babu Gauri Shankar Prasad Ji, an intimate followers of the Mahamana DAV College. The college got degree status from the University in 1947 and permanent affiliation in 1954. The College started running undergraduate courses in the faculty of Arts, Social Sciences and Commerce. In 2008 the University allowed the College with **co-education facility** to start Post Graduate and Ph.D. (research) programmes courses and presently college is running Ph.D. and Post Graduate programmes in nine departments. The College is also running UGDCA, Travel & Tourism Management, Risk & Insurance Management, Communicative English, Prayojan Mulak Hindi Patrakarita and Post Graduate Diploma in Counseling & Psychotherapy courses/programmes for the benefit of the students. The College is catering with distinction not only to the needs of the students of the eastern districts of U.P. but also the adjoining States like Bihar, Jharkhand, Uttarakhand, West Bengal & Madhya Pradesh and even very distant place of Arunachal Pradesh and Jammu & Kashmir (Laddakh). Due to college's distinguished record and the fact that DAV P.G. College has been awarded the highest grade 'A+' by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore in 2017, students of other far distinct States like Kashmir, West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh etc., also prefer to take admission in the college.*
